












Mum's funeral

<p>My mum died.</p> 	<p>A funeral is for people to say goodbye to someone who has died.</p> 	<p>Mum's funeral will be at a crematorium.</p> 	<p>Lots of people will be at Mum's funeral.</p> 
<p>Mum's body will be in a special box called a coffin. **I will not be able to see her.</p> 	<p>Mum cannot feel anything because she is not alive. Her body has stopped working.</p> 	<p>There may be photos of mum at the funeral.</p> 	<p>People will talk about mum at the funeral.</p> 
<p>People might cry – they feel sad that mum has died.</p> 	<p>People might smile or laugh – they may be thinking of happy times with mum.</p> 	<p>I will sit with dad and granny at the funeral. It is OK if I feel sad, if I cry or if I want to smile or laugh too.</p> 	<p>When we leave people may shake hands, hug and chat. This can help them to feel better.</p>
